Plant Variety Protection Act of 1970 (PVP), which offers legal protection in commerce for plant varieties reproduced by seed. U.S. Supreme Court rulings and 1994 Amendments to PVP state that:

- A farmer may increase and save seed of a new PVP variety to plant on his own farm. He cannot sell any saved seed without express permission from the variety owner. Also, if it was PVP title V protected, the seed must be sold as a class of certified seed.
- A seed processor is potentially liable if he cleans seed for another party who sells unauthorized seed.
- The variety owner can recover damage relating to unauthorized seed sales as well as crop production resulting from those sales.
- Labeling of seed is irrelevant in determining liability. The rules cannot be circumvented by marketing a PVP variety as "variety not stated" (VNS) or "grain", or buying grain or feed and converting it to planting purposes.
