ATTENTION: "Research Fee Agreement", between SEED PARTNER and MONTANA AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION will be required to obtain Foundation seed of Choteau, Vida, Yellowstone, Genou, Hockett & Craft. The SEED PARTNER shall pay to MAES a Research Fee for seed sale of \$0.30 / 60 lbs on a wheat variety and \$1.00 / 100 lbs of a barley variety. "Forage Research Fee" of \$10.50 per bushel Willow Creek is included in the price of Foundation Seed. Variety followed by ** are non-treated seed.

Farmers' Yield Initiative

The Farmers' Yield Initiative is a cooperative effort by public institutions, private companies, crop improvement and seed associations to educate the public and producers about the need for more agricultural research. Congress passed the Plant Variety Protection Act to encourage public institutions and private companies to invest in development of new plant varieties. MSU varieties, including Yellowstone, Genou, Choteau and Vida are protected by the PVP Act and may only be sold as a class of certified seed. While most producers respect the PVP law on protected varieties, there are some who seek to gain an unfair advantage over other producers by working outside the legal system. Please consider submitting a confidential tip to help curb illegal seed sales. It is anonymous and toll-free.
